# Stop Smoking Practitioner Programme (SSPP)



- National Certificate in Health, Disability and Aged Support Core Competencies (Level 3)
- 13 Unit Standards
- Face to Face HUB (two days)
- 8 months distance learning (training modules and assessments are online)
- Up to 2 hours per week, partially integrated into practice.
- Content has been refined after each intake, based on feedback from Students

## SSPP: Pilot, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Intake



- Over 75 students have completed the course, with at least 15 on track to finish in the next week.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> intake 35 students started in March and April
  - Homecare medical was prioritised by MOH
  - Individuals cannot enroll, students must be part of an organisation.

## SSPP: Current and future intakes



- 4<sup>th</sup> Intake will start in September 2016.
  - Numbers for 4<sup>th</sup> intake are likely to be much larger to allow all interested students to enroll.
- Recognition of prior learning process is in place and has been utilised by some students. This is not advertised and is offered to appropriate candidates.

# National Training Strategy



- MOH has mandated the NTS Strategy
- Purpose of the strategy is to ensure **Quality, Consistency, Standardisation** across **8 Training Areas**.
  - Core competencies, brief intervention, using medicines, advanced competencies, specialist groups, health promotion, service development, regulation and compliance
- To achieve this NTS is developing and implementing the NTS Alliance

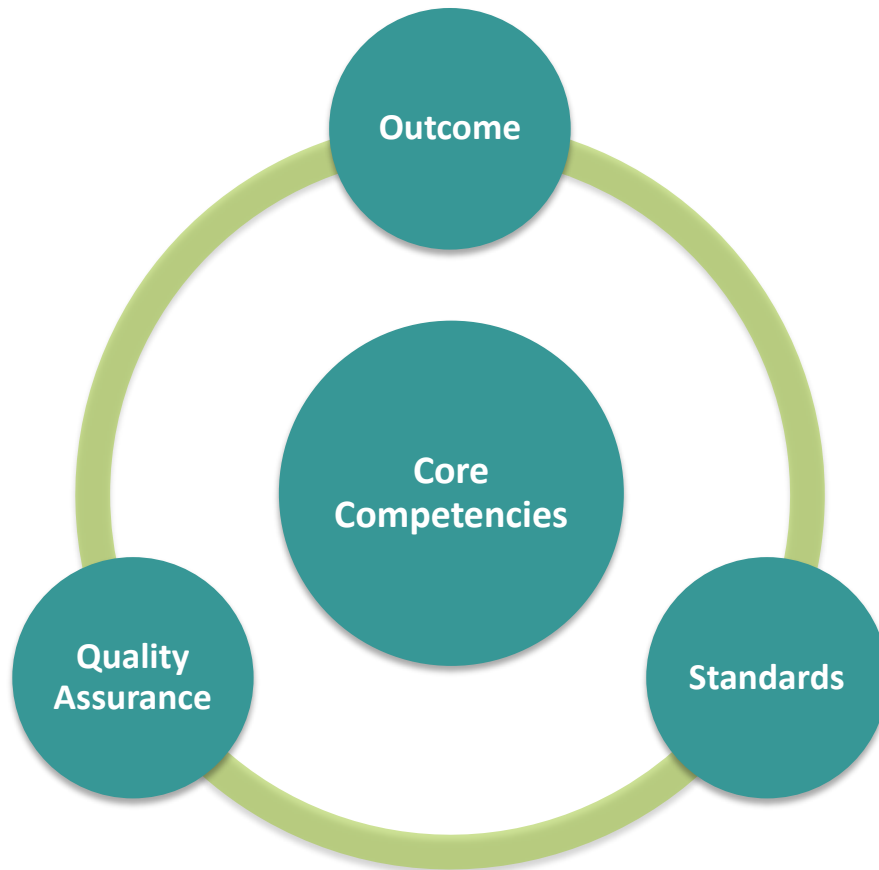
## National Training Outcomes
